

## RESOLUTION

*of the First National Symposium on Palaeontology in Romania  
Elaborated and approved on the 18th of October 1997*

- Art. 1.** The biannual organisation of the symposium by universities, research institutes, the Palaeontological Society of Romania or by natural science museums is instituted. All formalities will be fulfilled for the Symposium to be recognised by the IUGS and enter the international circuit.
- Art. 2.** The Symposium on Palaeontology will have an international character, being named the Symposium on Palaeontology and including thematic field-trips, pre- and post-symposium.
- Art. 3.** The tutorship of the President of Romania on the symposium is instituted.
- Art. 4.** The organising committee will include:
- an Honorary President;
  - a President
  - an Executive Vice-President;
  - a Vice-President;
  - a Secretary General;
  - members and a secretariat.
- Art. 5.** Participation fees for the symposium and the field-trips are instituted.
- Art. 6.** The President, Executive Vice-President and the Secretary General are in charge of obtaining the funds necessary for the organisation of the symposium.
- Art. 7.** The publication of a volume containing the proceedings of the symposium is instituted. The title of the volume will be *Acta Palaeontologica Romaniaae*.
- Art. 8.** The scientific proceedings of the symposium will be held in thematic sections.
- Art. 9.** The next symposium will be announced by three circulars which will be distributed in January, December and June.
- Art. 10.** The persons attending the proceedings of the symposium are obliged to advance to the Secretariat of the reunion two copies of the presented papers in English, within a period of 30 days from the closing of the symposium. The decision of publishing these papers pertains to the scientific board of the symposium, directed by the vice-president.

As a result of discussions carried on during the meeting mentioned above, it was established for the second symposium to be held at the University of Cluj, 10-15 October 1999.
